## CHAPTER 230

<b>SECTION 12.4 – PUBLIC NUISANCE</b>		
<b>When an owner or custodian allows an animal to:</b>		
	12.4.A.(1)	be at large
	12.4.A.(2)	damage the property of anyone other than its owner
	12.4.A.(3)	molest pedestrians, neighbors or passersby
	12.4.A.(4)	intimidate pedestrians, neighbors or passersby. Intimidation should be defined as when a reasonable prudent person under same or similar circumstances would have been threatened by the actions of the animal in question
	12.4.A.(5)	chase vehicles
	12.4.A.(6)	bark or make other harsh or excessive noise so as to disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of members of the community as reflected by reasonable persons with normal sensitivities
	12.4.A.(7)	foul the air by odor and thereby create unreasonable annoyance or discomfort to neighbors or others in close proximity to the premises where the animal is kept or harbored
	12.4.A (8)	defecate on public property and/or urinate/defecate on private property
	12.4.A.(9)	continue or repeat that behavior for which the animal has previously been determined by the Board to be a public nuisance by virtue of being a menace to the public health, welfare, or safety

<b>SECTION 12.5 – DANGEROUS AND/OR VICIOUS ANIMALS</b>		
	12.5.A.(1)	any animal which wounds, bites or otherwise injures a human being without provocation on public or private property
	12.5.A.(2)	any animal which has injured or killed a domestic animal without provocation
	12.5.A.(3)	any animal which has a vicious nature, disposition and/or propensity which is known or should be known by its owner or custodian
	12.5.A.(5)	any animal owned or harbored primarily or in part for the purpose of animal fighting, or any animal trained for animal fighting
	12.5.A.(6)	any animal not owned by a governmental or law enforcement unit, used primarily to guard public or private property
	12.5.C	Potentially dangerous animal, any animal that by its actions, constitutes a physical threat to human beings, other domestic animals, or both
