1 AN ACT concerning
2 **County Commissioners - Retirement Salaries.**

4 FOR the purpose of
5 Adding the office of Register of Wills to the list of elected public offices for which the
6 County Commissioners are required to appropriate annually a sum of money sufficient to finance
7 a retirement salary under certain circumstances as provided in the *Code of Charles County,*
8 *Maryland.*

16 **SECTION 1.** BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
17 CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Charles County, Maryland read as
18 follows:

Chapter 27
Commissioners, County

Section 27-16. Certain Appropriations Authorized.

* * *

E. Retirement salaries.

(1) The County Commissioners shall appropriate annually a sum of money sufficient to finance a retirement salary as provided in Paragraph (2) of this subsection to persons 65 years of age and over who no longer hold elective public office but who have held one of the following elected public offices of Charles County for the number of terms specified in Paragraph (2) of this subsection:

(a) County Commissioner.

(b) County Treasurer.

(c) State's Attorney.

(d) Judge of the Orphan's Court.

(E) REGISTER OF WILLS.

(2) Anyone who has held one or more of the elected public offices of Charles County enumerated in Paragraph of this subsection for a combined total of four full terms shall be entitled to an annual retirement salary in an amount equal to the total of 5 percent of each of the highest annual salaries received by the person for each year the official held office. However, the maximum annual retirement salary may not

1 exceed 80 percent of the highest annual salary the person received while holding
2 one of those offices. Further, the amount of any pension being paid to a person by
3 reason of retirement from employment with the county shall be subtracted from
4 any retirement salary payable under this subsection.

5
6 (3) The annual retirement salary provided for in this subsection shall be paid to the
7 recipient on a monthly basis.

8 * * *

9 **SECTION 2.** BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect FORTY-FIVE (45)
10 calendar days after it becomes law.
