Free Income Tax Preparation for Seniors & Moderate to Low-Income Adults

At the Richard R. Clark Senior Center

Beginning Monday, January 7, Senior I&A staff will begin accepting calls for persons who wish to schedule an appointment for the Annual Income Tax Preparation program. No Walk-ins accepted, appointments are required.

Eligibility Requirements: Persons age 60 and older who earned \$70,000 or less in tax year 2012 may call 301-609-5712 to schedule an appointment. Adults younger than age 60 who earned \$40,000 or less in tax year 2012 may schedule an appointment by calling 301-609-5704.

You must bring the following items with you to your appointment:

Identification card and social security card; prior year tax return; all 1099 and W-2 forms; 2012 property tax bill; if itemizing, documentation of medical, mortgage, and donation expenses.

This year's income tax preparation program will run each Monday and Friday, beginning February 4, 10 a.m.-2 p.m., at the Richard R. Clark Senior Center. This is a free service for persons who meet the eligibility guidelines.
