



Farebox & Magnetic Card Passenger Guide

VanGO's new farebox system is state-of-the-art in bus fare collection. The *GFI Odyssey Validating Farebox* handles all fare payments and options in one convenient, secure device.

Farebox Features

- ✓ Accepts coins and bills
- ✓ Accepts and processes VanGO cards and passes
- ✓ Issues transfer cards
- ✓ Accepts transfers issued by other *Odyssey* units
- ✓ Provides change cards and fare card upgrades
- ✓ Display shows transactions and remaining card value

How do I use the VanGO farebox?

ONE WAY FARE

- Step 1** Have your fare ready to insert into the farebox before boarding the bus. The farebox has a limit on the time you have to put your fare in the farebox.
- Step 2** Feed unfolded bills into the bill slot, and drop coins in the slot one at a time.
- Step 3** A digital display shows the exact amount deposited. When you hear a beep, you have paid the correct fare and may board the bus. If you have paid more than the fare amount owed, you must request a change card from the driver.

DAY PASS

- Step 1** Tell the driver in advance that you want to purchase a day pass **BEFORE** inserting your money into the farebox.
- Step 2** Then, insert your money into the farebox. The farebox will issue you a day pass, which is **ONLY** good for the day purchased.
- Step 3** Day passes are valid for unlimited rides until the expiration printed on the back. Each time you wish to use your day pass, simply swipe it through the card reader. When you hear a beep, the pass is recognized as valid. You may take your card and board the bus.

\$10 DISCOUNT PASS • AGENCY PASS • CHANGE CARD

- Step 1** Tell the driver in advance which type of fare you wish to purchase **BEFORE** inserting your card into the farebox.
- Step 2** Insert the card into the card slot. When you hear a beep, the card is recognized and the fare will be deducted. You may take your card and board the bus.
