DID YOU KNOW... Plastic bags can stop the single stream recycling process. Plastic bags get caught and jam the rotating discs at the material recovery facility, resulting in the sorting of recyclables to come to a stop. Please recycle plastic bags at local retail stores and don't place inside your cart.

Curbside recycling collection of single stream recycling is provided every other week, year-round. If your collection day falls on or after a major holiday, you will receive service the following day.

- ➔ Overflow should be in large, clear plastic bags and set on top of the cart's lid for collection. No black or white trash bags.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION: A separate truck collects yard waste, weekly, April through December. Yard Waste, including: grass, small branches, and leaves, must be in paper bags or in a reusable container less than 50 lbs., and marked with a large "X." Check online for additional yard waste collection specifications and restrictions.

RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING...

- Cardboard (flatten all boxes), Paper Bags, Office Paper, and File Folders
- Glass Jars and Bottles, Plastic Bottles, and Wide-Mouth Plastic Containers
- Food Boxes, Milk and Juice Cartons, Yogurt Cups, and Juice Boxes
- Metal Cans and Foils (Aluminum, Tin, and Steel Cans)
- Newspapers and Inserts, Magazines and Catalogs, Paper and Hardback Books, and Junk Mail

DO NOT PLACE IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

- Yard Waste or Tree Trimmings
- Lightbulbs, Window Glass, or Mirrors
- Styrofoam, Dishes and Ceramics, or Electronics
- Household Hazardous Waste or Motor Oil Containers
- Plastic Bags, Food Waste, or Garbage/Trash
