

RECYCLING INFORMATION

Charles County operates five recycling centers located in various parts of the county. In addition to these centers, curbside recycling service is provided to residents within the more densely populated areas of the county with expansions occurring as often as possible. **Blue bin materials are collected year-round on an every-other-week basis. Yard waste materials are collected weekly by a separate truck, April through December.** All materials must be placed curbside by 7:00 AM to ensure pickup.

Please note: For safety reasons, contractor employees are not permitted to physically cross the street. Therefore, recycling materials are serviced on the passenger side of the collection vehicle only.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The recycling schedule located within this brochure has been designed to aid residents who currently receive curbside service in determining exactly what weeks their bins should be placed curbside during the calendar year 2012. **Please note: Areas added to the curbside recycling route after the new year are added to the next year's calendar.** Please contact the Division of Environmental Resources at 301.932.3599 if you have any questions.

Blue Bin Materials Accepted Curbside

Every-Other-Week • Year-Round

Aluminum and Tin Cans / Glass Bottles and Jars / Plastic Bottles and Jugs (rinse all containers); Newspapers, White Paper, Magazines, Glossy Inserts, Telephone Books and Flattened Cardboard.

All items can be mixed together.

Items not accepted in your blue bin include: formed boxes, plastic bags, buckets, toys, diapers, food containers, light bulbs, ceramics, and trash. Contaminated oil and antifreeze containers are not recyclable.

Yard Waste Materials Accepted Curbside

Weekly • April through December

Grass, leaves, bundled brush and branches - Place material in paper yard waste bags or in trash cans that have handles and are **marked with a yard waste sticker or a large "X"** facing the street. The maximum weight per container is 50 pounds. Branches cannot exceed 4 feet in length or 6 inches in diameter.

Items not accepted as yard waste include: loose branches and brush, plastic bags, dirt, rocks, sod and trash. Yard waste that exceeds 50 pounds, 4 feet in length, or 6 inches in diameter is not accepted curbside.

CHARLES COUNTY LANDFILL

The Charles County landfill, located at 12305 Billingsley Road in Waldorf, is open Monday through Saturday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM (**Vehicles weighing 10,000 pounds or more must be exiting the outbound scale by 4:00 PM; vehicles weighing less than 10,000 pounds must be exiting by 5:00 PM.**) The recycling center and Tag-a-Bag program remain available until 7:00 PM. In addition to Sundays, the landfill may be closed in observance of six major holidays (as listed on the attached calendar). **Residents are reminded to obey vehicle covering laws, posted speed limits throughout the landfill area, and the traffic signals stationed at the inbound and outbound scales. Children must remain in vehicles at all times.** For further landfill information, please call 301.932.9038.

Residential Landfill Fees*

The tipping fee for residential use of the landfill is \$70.00 per ton or, if requested, a flat rate fee of \$5.00 per car/ \$15.00 per pick-up truck (no ladder racks, sideboards, commercial vehicles, or trailers). **The flat rate fee must be requested prior to exiting the in-bound scale.** There is no charge for residential disposal of recyclable materials (with the exception of scrap tires).

Tag-A-Bag Program

Charles County's Tag-A-Bag program enables residents to dispose household trash for **\$1.00 per container up to 32 gallons. Containers exceeding 32 gallons require additional tickets.** The more you recycle, the less trash you have, the more money you save! Trash compactors for the Tag-a-Bag program are located at the landfill, Pisgah, Gilbert Run, and the Breeze Farm recycling centers.

Residential Materials Accepted at Recycling Centers

- ✓ All Curbside Items – Tin and Aluminum Cans, Glass Bottles and Jars, Plastic Bottles and Jugs, Newspaper, White Paper, Magazines, Glossy Inserts, Telephone Books, Flattened Cardboard.
All materials can be mixed together.
- ✓ Batteries – Household, Cell, and Auto.
- ✓ Electronics – Computers, laptops, speakers, televisions, stereo equipment, DVD/VCR players, microwaves, cell phones. Please hand cell phones to attendant on duty. **For safety and security reasons, only attendants are allowed in electronics disposal area.**
- ✓ Scrap Metal - Appliances, Bicycles, Lawn Mowers, Metal Furniture, etc.
- ✓ Scrap Tires - Two **residential** tires per visit accepted free of charge. Bulk loads and commercial size tires are only accepted over the landfill scales.
- ✓ Textiles - Clothing, Shoes, Draperies. **Useable items must be clean, dry, and bagged.**
- ✓ Used Cooking Oil – Waste oil from a deep fryer, frying pan, or wok. (No material from grease traps.) **Used cooking oil is accepted at the landfill recycling center only.**
- ✓ Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze - **Do not mix together**; dispose empty containers in the trash. **No brake fluids.**
- ✓ Yard Waste – 10 bag maximum at recycling centers. Plastic bags must be discarded in the trash. Larger amounts and pick-up truck loads of yard waste are only accepted at the compost yard within the landfill. **Stumps are not accepted.**

24-Hour Used Motor Oil & Antifreeze Collection Sites

The following sites have collection tanks available for the purpose of recycling used motor oil and antifreeze. Residents are reminded to carefully pour the two different type fluids into designated tanks and to properly dispose all empty containers in the trash. Cooking oils and brake fluids are **not accepted**.

YARD WASTE STICKERS

Curbside collection **yard waste stickers are available free-of-charge at the following locations:** American Hardware, Bannister Neighborhood Center, Bryans Road Hardware, Charles County Sanitary Landfill, Charles Crossing Neighborhood Center, Dorchester Neighborhood Center, Hampshire Neighborhood Center, Hanson Community Center, Henson Community Center, Home Depot, Kingsview Neighborhood Center, Lancaster Neighborhood Center, Longwood Nursery, Lowes, Mat-tawoman Community Center, Somers Community Center, Stoddert Community Center, Wade Community Center, and Wakefield Neighborhood Center. **Please note: In lieu of yard waste stickers, containers may also be marked with a large “X”. The yard waste sticker or the large “X” must be visible to the driver to ensure service.**

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

Adopt-A-Road Program

Charles County continues to encourage residents to help combat the ever-increasing problem of littering by "adopting" a county road. Volunteers receive sign recognition in exchange for cleaning "their" road three (3) times in a calendar year (cleaning must be reported for credit). Gloves, bags, and safety vests are all provided free of charge as well as trash disposal (upon notification).

Free Mulch Program

Through Charles County's Christmas tree and yard waste collection programs, free mulch is available year-round (while supplies last). **Residents must bring pitch fork and load mulch themselves.**

Landfill Compost Facility: Saturdays only, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Loading of vehicles is available at this site March through September on Saturdays from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

HHW - Household Hazardous Waste Collection

Residential household hazardous waste collection is held the first Saturday of each month, April through December, at the Department of Public Works, 10430 Audie Lane (off of Radio Station Road) in La Plata, from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Items accepted free of charge include pesticides, fertilizer, gasoline, fluorescent lights, oil-based paint, cleaning supplies, pool chemicals, batteries, prescription drugs, and other poisons that are around your house. Please keep the materials in their original containers whenever possible and bring them to the collection site in cardboard boxes to ease unloading. **Commercially generated hazardous waste is strictly prohibited.**

Latex Paint

Did you know that thousands of tax dollars are spent each year on latex paint disposed as hazardous waste? In fact, latex paint is not considered hazardous and can be placed in your household trash as long as it is solidified. Solidifying can be accomplished by adding kitty litter, shredded paper, sawdust, or old rags to the liquid latex paint to aid in drying it out. Paint solidifiers can also be purchased in hardware stores. Please call the Division of Environmental Resources at 301-932-3599 for additional information.

PRWC - Potomac River Watershed Cleanup

The **24th Annual Potomac River Watershed Cleanup** will take place Saturday, April 14, 2012, 9:00 AM to NOON, **rain or shine**. This is an excellent opportunity for high school community service hours and merit badges. School yard, community cleanups and Adopt-A-Road cleanups are also strongly encouraged. Water Conservation Tips

- Run your clothes washer and dishwasher only when they are full. You can save up to 1,000 gallons of water a month.
- Monitor your water bill for unusually high use. Your bill and water meter are tools that can help you discover leaks.
- Put food coloring in your toilet tank. If it seeps into the toilet bowl without flushing, you have a leak. Fixing it can save up to 1,000 gallons a month.
- Look for products bearing the EPA WaterSense Label for items that have been certified to save 20% or more without sacrificing performance.
