

Minutes – May 29, 2014

The following members of the Board were present at the County Commissioners' Meeting Room, Charles County Government Building, for a regular hearing of the Board of License Commissioners: Wayne Magoon, Vice Chairman; Thomasina Coates, and William B. Young. In addition, Associate County Attorney Matthew Clagett, and Gina Markovich, Acting Clerk/Recording Secretary, were in attendance.

1. William Howard Grow, Halfway Liquors & Bar, Inc., t/a Halfway Market & Deli, 6970 Hawthorne Road, La Plata, Maryland 20646, for a transfer of the Class D – Beer, Wine & Liquor (on/off sale) alcoholic beverage license from Anne Marie Woodford, Halfway Liquors & Bar, Inc., 6970 Hawthorne Road, La Plata, Maryland 20646.. Counsel to the applicant was John Mudd, Esq. & Issac McAdams. Testimony was presented by the applicant as to the facts contained in the application, including evidence that Mr. Grow is a member of Halfway Liquors & Bar, Inc., holding 20% interest in the corporation and serves as resident licensee. The remaining 80% interest in Halfway Liquors & Bar, Inc. is held by Gerri Lynn Dixon King. The applicant also testified that no further change in the type of business is contemplated at this time. Upon consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, and upon a motion duly made, seconded and unanimously approved, the Board approved the transfer contingent upon payment of the appropriate transfer fee.
