27 **SECTION 1.** BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
28 CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Charles County, Maryland read as
29 follows:

30 **§ 175-1. County authorized to award grants.**

31 A. Charles County may award grants of funds or in-kind assistance to nonprofit agencies
32 which provide services to County residents. Grant awards shall be made as part of the

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
annual budget approval process.


- B. Grants are initiated when a nonprofit agency requests a grant to provide a certain service or when the County solicits nonprofit agencies to provide a certain service.
- C. Applicants must submit a grant request to the appropriate County department or office on the prescribed form, by [December 31] THE THIRD FRIDAY IN JANUARY, in order to be considered for a grant for the following year.
- D. Grants may be funded with County funds or from designated private, state, regional, or federal funds.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect FORTY-FIVE (45) calendar days after its enactment.


