

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-46

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, held a public hearing on May 25, 2011, to consider the FY 2012 Water and Sewer Operating Budgets for Charles County, and

WHEREAS, based on information presented at the public hearing, the County Commissioners deem it appropriate to institute new rates for water and sewer user charges in Charles County.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion made, duly seconded and carried, it is HEREBY ORDAINED this 15th day of June, 2011, by the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, as follows:

1. That Resolution No. 2010-46 is hereby repealed.
2. That the user rate for sewer services charged by Charles County will be (per 1,000 gallons):


Single Family Residential: Usage capped at 24,000 gallons.....	\$5.83
Multi-Family/Commercial: Metered Usage.....	\$5.83
3. That the user rate for water services charged by Charles County will be (per 1,000 gallons):

Single Family Residential: 0 - 18,000 gallons.....	\$2.67
Single Family Residential: 18,001-24,000 gallons.....	\$5.34
Single Family Residential: over 24,001 gallons.....	\$8.01
Multi-Family/Commercial: Metered Usage.....	\$3.45
4. That an account maintenance fee of \$8.88 will be rendered with each quarterly bill for water and sewer billing and \$4.00 each for sewer only billing.
5. That "Quarterly Non-Metered Rates" as shown on the attached Exhibit A are hereby adopted.

6. That this Ordinance will take effect on July 1, 2011.
