Resolution No. 2011-58

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, recognize the importance of our County history and heritage of Native Americans and the establishment in 1658; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Charles County, assumed internal operations of the Crain Memorial Highway Welcome Center from the Maryland Office of Tourism; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Charles County recognize the importance of establishing a Charles County museum for the enjoyment of our citizens and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, a museum is an institution that houses and cares for a collection of artifacts and other objects of scientific, artistic, or historical importance and makes them available for public viewing through exhibits that may be permanent or temporary;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, as follows:

- I. That the Crain Memorial Highway Welcome Center be identified as the location of the Charles County Museum, in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding with the Maryland Office of Tourism and State Highway Administration.
- II. That should the Crain Memorial Highway Welcome Center no longer be available, the County will identify an alternate, suitable location.
- III. That The Office of Tourism Promotions Specialist shall record, catalog, and inventory items received for the Museum.
- IV. That the Museum may purchase or borrow items of historical significance for the Charles County Museum, as determined by the Office of Tourism.
- V. That each Museum item shall be marked with identifying characteristics, easily identifiable to the public.
- VI. That the Charles County Office of Tourism will promote the Museum through traditional marketing materials and the website.

AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution is effective this 26th day of July, 2011.
