WHEREAS, the Benedict Waterfront Village Revitalization Plan was initiated in 2010 to form a community-based vision for Benedict's future; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies and prioritizes physical improvements to enhance the image of Benedict as a unique waterfront area in Charles County; and

WHEREAS, public participation for this plan included public meetings on November 13, 2010 and January 22, 2011, interviews with key stakeholders, a community survey, visual preference exercise, historic village walk, community boat tour, and a project website; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the draft plan on May 23, 2011 to hear public comment followed by a work session on August 8, 2011 where the plan was recommended for approval by the Charles County Planning Commission with a unanimous vote; and




