WHEREAS, our form of government dictates and our citizens are best served by a diverse set of leaders, with a diverse set of opinions and ideas from different parts of the County; and

WHEREAS, we affirm our commitment to open government; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2012-18 was adopted on April 10, 2012; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to provide for certain actions or approvals by majority vote of the board;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, the delegated authority on fiscal expenditures previously in effect shall remain in force;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the references in Resolution 2012-18, page two, in paragraphs numbered 5, 5c, 5d and 6 to the “full board”, be and the same are hereby changed to a “majority of the Board”;

AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that other provisions of Resolution 2012-18 remain unchanged.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, that this RESOLUTION shall take effect immediately.




