

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-09

A RESOLUTION concerning Joint Land Use Study with Naval Support Facility Dahlgren.

WHEREAS, Charles County recognizes that the County has been included in the Study Area for a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) for Naval Support Facility (NSF) Dahlgren, located in King George County, Virginia, since operations at this Facility can potentially affect land and water uses in Charles County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a JLUS is to encourage cooperative land use planning between military installations and the surrounding communities so that future civilian growth and development are compatible with the training, test, or operational missions of the installation; and to seek ways to reduce operational impacts on adjacent lands; and

WHEREAS, Charles County agrees to participate in the NSF Dahlgren JLUS in an advisory capacity to assist in identifying issues and formulating policies and an action strategy to promote compatibility between Charles County and NSF Dahlgren; and

WHEREAS, the other local government participants in the NSF Dahlgren JLUS include King George County, Virginia, as study sponsor; Westmoreland County, Virginia; Town of Colonial Beach, Virginia; Caroline County, Virginia; and St. Mary's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes that participation in an advisory capacity in the NSF Dahlgren JLUS will benefit the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Charles County; and

WHEREAS, no commitment of Charles County funds is required, as this JLUS is

being sponsored by King George County, Virginia, Board of Supervisors, who will apply for the grant assistance to support the cost of the JLUS, and be responsible for the required match and other related study management functions.



ADOPTED this 26th day of February 2013, by the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland.


