

**COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-10**

A RESOLUTION concerning Joint Land Use Study with Naval Support Indian Head and the Town of Indian Head.

WHEREAS, Charles County recognizes that continued operation of the Naval Support Facility (NSF) Indian Head is important to both the Charles County local economy and the economy of southern Maryland, and that its future operational capacity should be protected; and

WHEREAS, Charles County is volunteering to sponsor and prepare a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) in cooperation with the Town of Indian Head and NSF Indian Head to coordinate future planning efforts of NSF Indian Head and Charles County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a JLUS is to encourage cooperative land use planning between military installations and the surrounding communities so that future civilian growth and development are compatible with the training, test, or operational missions of the installation; and to seek ways to reduce operational impacts on adjacent lands; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes that participation in the development of a JLUS will benefit the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Charles County; and

WHEREAS, the County will act as the fiscal agent for grant funds from the Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment, understanding a JLUS for NSF Indian Head with two participating jurisdictions could cost approximately \$150,000 depending on consultant responses to the Request for Proposal process; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Adjustment, can contribute up 90 percent of


the cost to produce a JLUS; and


WHEREAS, the remaining 10 percent non-Federal match of the cost can include local funds or dedicated staff resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County as follows: that Charles County agrees to sponsor the development of a JLUS for NSF Indian Head; that the County agrees to form a JLUS Policy Committee and JLUS Technical Advisory Group; that the County agrees to consider funding its matching share of the cost of the JLUS once determined by the Policy Committee and brought back to this Board and that the County commits to a good faith effort to implement the JLUS recommendations.


