**WHEREAS**, it is desirable to modify said purposes;




1. To act as a referral source for women needing assistance;
2. To support and encourage programs of benefit to women;
3. To publicize activities and services of interest to women;
4. To encourage educational and job training opportunities for women;
5. To promote public forums on women's needs and problems;
6. To advocate and publicize proposed legislation that affects women;
7. To promote continued equal opportunity for women; and
8. To operate at all times and in all matters as a non-political, non-partisan commission.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.




