

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-18

A RESOLUTION concerning Joint Land Use Study with Naval Support Facility Dahlgren.

WHEREAS, Charles County has participated in a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) for Naval Support Facility (NSF) Dahlgren, located in King George County, Virginia, since operations at this Facility can potentially affect land and water uses in Charles County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a JLUS is to encourage cooperative land use planning between military installations and the surrounding communities so that future civilian growth and development are compatible with the training, testing, and/or operational missions of the installation; and to seek ways to reduce operational impacts on adjacent lands; and

WHEREAS, Charles County agreed to participate in the NSF Dahlgren JLUS in an advisory capacity to assist in identifying issues and formulating policies and an action strategy to promote compatibility between Charles County and NSF Dahlgren; and

WHEREAS, the other local government participants in the NSF Dahlgren JLUS include King George County, Virginia, as study sponsor; Westmoreland County, Virginia; Town of Colonial Beach, Virginia; and St. Mary's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the JLUS process, facilitated with an outside consultant, has been completed, and the JLUS Final Report has been accepted by the JLUS Policy Committee; and

WHEREAS, the JLUS Final Report has been formally accepted by the King George County, Virginia, Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the King George County Board of Supervisors has requested in a letter dated March 10, 2015, that each participating jurisdiction in the JLUS, including Charles County, take formal action to accept the NSF Dahlgren JLUS Final Report; and

WHEREAS, once the Final Report is accepted by each participating jurisdiction, an implementation coordinating committee will be established whose membership would initially comprise those jurisdictions who also served on the NSF Dahlgren JLUS Technical Advisory Group, including a representative from Charles County, to track the progress of implementation; and

WHEREAS, at their regular meeting on May 4, 2015, the Charles County Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend that the Board of Charles County Commissioners adopt this Resolution to formally accept the JLUS Final Report; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the final NSF Dahlgren Joint Land Use Study is attached to this resolution; and


WHEREAS, the NSF Dahlgren JLUS Final Report establishes a framework through which local governments can participate with NSF Dahlgren to understand compatibility issues, encourage cooperative land use and resource planning, and establish a set of mutually supported tools, activities and procedures through which the plan can be implemented.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County as follows: that Charles County accepts the Final Report for the NSF Dahlgren Joint Land Use Study (JLUS), as it pertains to Charles County, Maryland.


