

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND

Resolution No. 2011-74

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, §17-1006 requires certain individuals doing business as a junk dealer or scrap metal processor in the State of Maryland be licensed to engage in said business; and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, §17-1003 requires that a county or municipal governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held shall designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records in accordance with §17-1011(b) of the Business Regulations Article.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, as follows:

1. That the Office of the Sheriff for Charles County, Maryland is hereby designated as the Primary Law Enforcement Unit for Charles County in regards to the enforcement of the regulations as set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article § 17-1001 et al; and

2. That the Office of the Sheriff for Charles County, Maryland shall receive records in accordance with § 17-1011 (b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.

Finally, IT IS RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the 25th day of October, 2011, and apply immediately upon the signatures of the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland.


